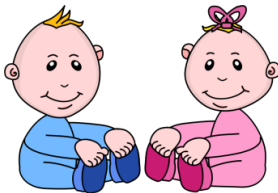
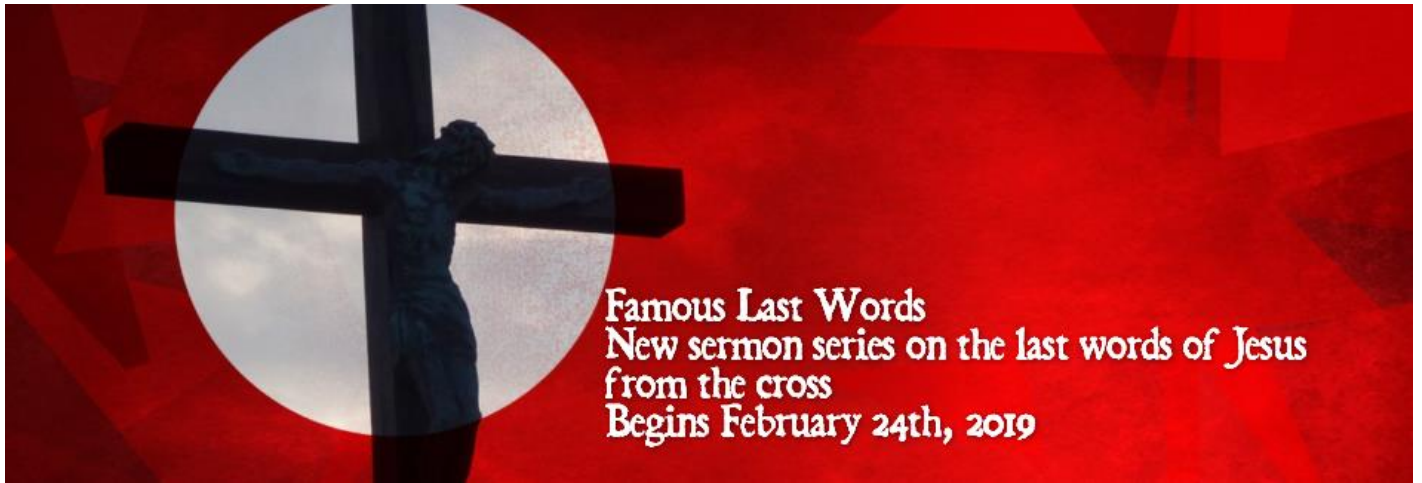
New Young Adult and Young Married Group
